
#### Utility Driving August 6, 2025

- 6. 90 degree pivot left
- 7. Walk a few steps, Park Gait a few strides, and then Road Gait to the simulated bridge.
- 8. Walk over simulated bridge, stop & settle. Pattern complete





- 5. Stop and back approximately one horse length.



#### Ranch Reining Pattern #4




#### Pattern can be a trot or Lope in Pattern

- Beginning on the left lead complete two circle to the left, The first circle small and slow, the next circle large and fast, Change leads at the center of arena
- Complete two circles to the right, The first circle small and slow, the next circle large and fast, Change leads in the center of the arena.
- Begin large circle to left, but do not close the circle, run down the right side of the arena past center marker, and roll back right, no hesitation.
- Continue around the end of the arena to run down the left side of the arena past center marker and do a left roll back, no hesitation.
- Run past the middle marker, Stop, Back up 10 feet, 1/4 turn to right, ½
  turn to left, ¼ turn to Right.
  Hesitate to complete pattern.



#### RANCH TRAIL

August 7, 2025



- 1. Right hand push gate
- 2. Trot to Drag. Novice = pick up bucket / Amateur & Open = drag log walk or trot circle
- 3. Left lead to bridge.
- 4. Walk Bridge & into Chute
- 5. Back L, Walk out.
- 6. Trot a few strides then extend the trot over the logs
- 7. Stop & sidepass left between logs.
- 8. Walk forward then Right Lead over logs.
- 9. Trot serpentine
- 10. Walk logs

Zone - all Ranch Pleasure = Pattern 2 (classes 202, 204, 206) - August 7, 2025 Pattern will be performed on the outside of the Ranch Trail pattern Markers may or may not be used - use the distances to best show your horse **Extended Walk Extended Trot Extended Lope** 8 Back //////// 9


When establishing the course, the following distances are suggested. Patterns may begin in either direction and markers are optional.

- I. Walk from I to 2 30 feet
- 2. Lope from 2 to 3 I50 feet
- 3. Extended Lope from 3 to 4 200 feet
- 4. Trot from 4 to 5 I20 feet
- 5. Stop at 5; reverse (either direction)
- 6. Extended Walk from 6 to 7 75 feet
- 7. Trot from 7 to 8 90 feet
- 8. Extended Trot from 8 to 9 240 feet
- 9. Lope from 9 to 10 150 feet
- 10. Stop and Back at 10 approximately one horse length

- 7. Trot logs into chute & stop.
- 8. Back L
- 9. Walk out over logs.
- 10. Trot to Drag. Novice = pick up bucket / Open & Amateur = drag. Walk or trot circle. Return bucket / drag and trot out.

INPHC - all Ranch Pleasure = Pattern 1 (classes 202, 204, 206) - August 9, 2025 pattern will be performed on the outside of the Ranch Trail pattern - markers may or may not be used - use the distances to best show your horse



When establishing the course, the following distances are suggested. Patterns may begin in either direction and markers are optional.

- 3. Extended Trot from 3 to 4 240 feet

- 7. Lope from 7 to 8 150 feet
- 8. Extended Lope from 8 to 9 200 feet
- 9. Trot from 9 to 10 90 feet
- 10. Stop and Back at 10 approximately one horse length



#### **INPHC**

#### All Ranch Reining (#146, #147, & #148)

August 10, 2025



- 1. Start at end of arena. Run down middle past center marker to a sliding stop.
- 2. Back at least 10 feet to center. 1/4 turn left.
- 3. Pickup right lead, big fast circle, small slow circle.
- 4. Change leads to left, big fast circle, small slow circle.
- 5. Change leads to right, do not close this circle.
- 6. Run around end of arena and down the side (approximately 20 feet from fence) past center marker and come to a sliding stop.
- 7. Complete 3 1/2 turns to the right.
- 8. Continue back down side and end of arena to other side (approximately 20 feet from fence) go past center marker and come to a sliding stop.
- 9. Complete 3 1/2 turns to the left.
- 10. Hesitate to complete pattern.
