- No changing stall location between Idaho & Zone
- RVs must be canceled by 4pm Mtn Std Time FIVE (5) days prior to reserved arrival to avoid loss of RV deposit. RV spaces are full hook up at \$60/night
- Zone stall reservations not canceled prior to 4pm Mtn Std Time FIVE (5) days prior to reserved arrival will be charged for their stalls IN FULL unless vet documentation is provided.

Those competing in both the Idaho Paint and/or Zone One/INPHC shows will have priority stabling location until July 20, 2025 (those attending Idaho Paint only have priority in Barn W). Ford Idaho Horse Park has final decision regarding assigned stall locations.

If you submit your form indicating that you will be arriving for, or during the Idaho Paint Horse show, you will be charged for the dates indicated on the form, whether you arrive after that date or not. 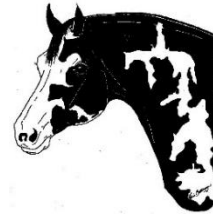

High Point & Reserve Categories (halter required) – Must Show To All 10 Judges

Per rule 14: HIGH POINT ELIGIBILITY (ALL Divisions): **All High Point awards will be calculated using all 10 judges.** The Horse must compete under each set of judges in at least three (3) performance classes in a High Point Division **PLUS their respective halter class** (Novice or W/T must compete in their respective youth/amateur halter class; ranch horses can compete in either halter or conformation) to qualify. All classes (except Color) in each division will count. One Horse / One Rider combination to apply to all Youth & Amateur High Points.

- 1st place circuit winner in all classes gets a certificate for a Custom buckle (to be shipped after the show, some stock buckles will be available for those who don't want to wait). Will be an option to combine multiple buckles into other award items.

- Credit cards have 4% convenience fee added to the total.

Canadian exhibitors pay par in US funds only (credit card, US cash, or US check)
(no Canadian checks accepted – Canadian cash OK at regular show bill total)

We will be using Horse Show Tracker as our primary entry source as well as for posting the Zone One class circuit award winners

Tips to make entering with Tracker easier:

- Set up your People (owners, exhibitors, trainers) as well as your Horses from a desktop computer (this process is easier from a desktop than the mobile version for the initial set up)
- TRIPLE CHECK YOUR DATA ENTRY – however you spell the name of a horse or person or whatever membership or registration number you enter is how the results will get submitted to APHA. If you have that information wrong, you could end up with an issue getting your results tabulated correctly at APHA

2025 Overall Show Rules

Make All Checks Payable To ZONE ONE. Checks will be deposited promptly. NO POST DATED CHECKS. There will be a \$50 fee assessed for EACH time a check is returned by the bank. Credit cards have 4% convenience fee.

1. Dogs MUST be on a leash at all times & pick up after them. Dogs are not allowed inside the Sports Center arena building unless they are an actual disability dog (per Nampa city ordinance).
2. **NO ALCOHOL allowed in the SportsCenter.**
3. **NO FOOD & BEVERAGE allowed in the SportsCenter not purchased from OVG Hospitality.**
4. Do not wash or rinse your horses off in the stalls or alleyways – use the designated wash rack area only. NO washing of vehicles or trailers in the designated wash rack area.
5. NO smoking in any building or in the stall areas.
6. All drivers of golf carts, motorcycles, scooters or other motorized vehicles on the Ford Idaho Horse Park grounds must have a valid drivers license in their state of residence.
7. Upon arrival, please check in at the Horse Park office to receive your stall & RV assignment.
8. Unsportsmanlike conduct will be referred to show management and an APHA Professional Horseman for appropriate action (including expulsion from the grounds and referral to APHA per **GR-066**
9. An entry in the Zone One Zone-O-Rama (6 judges) or into the Inland Northwest Paint Horse Club Paint-O-Rama (4 judges) is considered an entry under ALL judges for that show.
10. Show management may combine or split classes according to APHA rules **SC 185.G , AM 080.B and YP 075.B.**
If classes are combined to make an APHA point class, only ONE set of awards will be given.
11. Anyone withdrawing (scratching) from a class after entering without TWO (2) class notice shall forfeit their entry fee in accordance with **RULE SC-185.A** (exception for non-point classes).
12. **Zone One Class Circuit Awards** – will be posted on Horse Show Tracker. Scored classes will go to the highest cumulative score. Placed classes are calculated by which exhibitors place best under all 6 judges, then which exhibitors place best under 5 of the 6 judges, and so on.
13. Exhibitors/Owners competing for High Point or Special Awards are responsible for entering the correct classes to qualify for all awards. Award qualifying class lists will be available at the show.
14. **HIGH POINT ELIGIBILITY (ALL Divisions):** *All High Point awards will be calculated using all 10 judges.* The Horse must compete under each set of judges in at least three (3) performance classes in a High Point Division **PLUS their respective halter class** (Novice or W/T must compete in their respective youth/amateur halter class; ranch horses can compete in either halter or conformation) to qualify. All classes (except Color) in each division will count. One Horse / One Rider combination to apply to all Youth & Amateur High Points.
 - **TIES** will be broken using the following: (1) showing the least number of classes; (2) earning the most firsts; (3) places the most times; then (4) the flip of a coin.
15. **HIGH POINT HALTER STALLION, MARE & GELDING AWARDS** will be calculated using only the Grand and Reserve placings *using all 10 judges.* Grand will receive 2 points and Reserve will receive 1 point. Ties will be broken by the most Grands being the winner unless that is also a tie, then the winner of the most Grands and Reserves will receive the award. If that is a tie, flip of a coin.
16. **INPHC Randy Eppers Memorial High Point Halter Horse** – placings in all INPHC halter classes that horse enters will count (youth class, amateur class & open class placings combined).
17. **INPHC Walt Dinning Memorial High Point Halter Mare** – grands & reserves in the INPHC portion of the Open Halter mares will count
18. **INPHC Harold Kruger Memorial High Point Speed Horse** – placings in all INPHC open speed classes that horse enters will count

19. **INPHC Eunice Long & Darlene Beplate & Margaret Morton Memorial awards** – awarded to the open Sr. hunter under saddle, open yearling longeline, & amateur performance halter gelding class average winners in the INPHC classes.
20. **CHALLENGES** to awards placings / calculations must be made within 2 hours after that class for circuit awards or halter high points. For high point, within 1 hour after the end of the show Sunday.
21. **HIGH POINT AWARDS WILL NOT BE ANNOUNCED UNTIL AT LEAST ONE (1) HOUR AFTER THE LAST QUALIFYING CLASS. Awards MUST be picked up by the end of the show or be forfeited, unless arrangements are made to deliver awards.**
22. All Amateur & Youth pattern classes will be run in the published working order. If you miss your working order, you may be disqualified. If you are showing multiple horses in any pattern class, it is your responsibility to request a change in the working order with the gate steward before the class begins.
23. **Exhibitor Responsibility: SC-160.E** - Exhibitors are responsible for being knowledgeable of and following the current rules, completing entry forms legibly and accurately, reporting to the gate promptly and being considerate of other exhibitors and show management. Additionally, exhibitors, owners and trainers are responsible to be knowledgeable of **Rule SC-085** Drugs and Medications, forbidden, permitted & conditionally permitted substances. Conditionally permitted substances require a completed medication report be filed with show office. **Inhumane treatment of animals on the grounds will not be tolerated. Rule SC-075. Proper action WILL be taken.**
24. The Show Secretary or office staff **MUST** inspect the registration papers (or copies of) on each horse entered (current year foals need to bring their registration work order). Entries shall be made in the name of the recorded owner per **Rule SC 160.C**. Geldings are not allowed to show with stallion papers.
25. **Leased Horses** – the show secretary or office staff **MUST** inspect the APHA show lease certificate according to rules **AM-020.A.1.f & YP-015.A.2.f**.
26. To enter **Amateur** or **Novice Amateur** classes, you **MUST** present a current year APHA Amateur or Novice Amateur card, and own your horse according to **Rule AM-015, AM-210 and AM-300.C. (exception for Walk/Trot AM.300.D)**
27. **Novice Youth & Walk/Trot 11-18** must present a current Novice Youth or Walk/Trot Card from APHA in order to enter any Novice Youth or Walk/Trot 11-18 Class, per **YP-109 & YP-210**. Additionally, Novice Youth may cross enter into the age appropriate Youth Class. Youth must present an AjPHA membership card in order to enter any youth classes **Rule YP-005.A.5**.
28. **All Exhibitors AND Owners must present a current APHA membership card – if you do not have a current membership, that can be purchased at the show office. Rule SC-160.A.**
29. If you fail to present the necessary membership cards or to obtain the proper card before leaving the show, you will be assessed a \$50 fee for each card (will be billed after the show). If you fill out the appropriate paperwork, that fee will be applied towards the application fee with APHA. Otherwise, funds become the property of Zone One and INPHC.
30. The condition of submitting entries or the first entry into the show ring of a horse or exhibitor shall be deemed as acceptance of the APHA Official Rule Book and the Zone One / INPHC General Rules.
31. The final right to settle all questions or disputes arising incidentally to the Zone One Zone-O-Rama or the INPHC Paint-O-Rama is reserved to the Show Management. All exhibitors, owners and trainers, as condition of admission, give unqualified consent to such methods of settlement and agree in advance to be bound thereby.
32. Exhibitors & horses showing in the first 5 classes of the show each day **MUST** be entered in the show office no later than 30 minutes prior to the published start time or may not be allowed to show. Show management reserves the right to close individual class entry **TWO (2)** classes prior to that class. If we allow entry at the gate, please do not abuse it – all class entries should be made in the show office in advance of your class.
